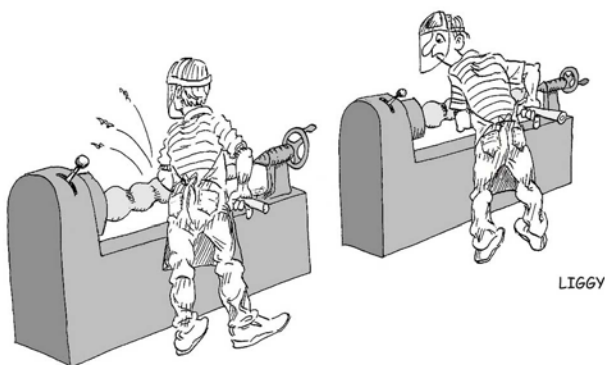

Time to pay dues for the 2024 - 2025 year. WVWW is now able to use credit cards to collect dues. Dues may be paid at the November meeting.

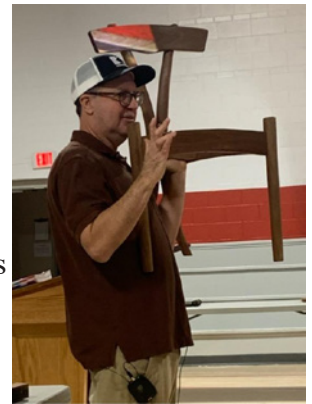

### Check out the website

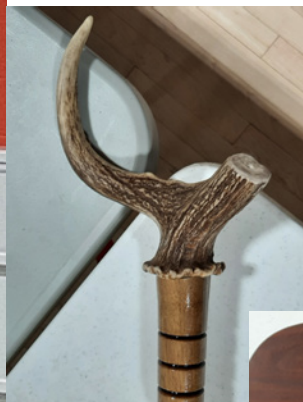
